Top Ten Things Band Parents Need to Know

1) What Your Child **MUST** Bring to Each Class

Their Instrument and **Their Music Book** (and any sheet music they have received)

Extra Reeds (clarinets and saxes only) Students will need about 15-20 reeds for the entire year.

Buy #2 reeds. You can find them at most local music stores. Music stores are listed below.

2) When looking for an instrument for your child, we recommend certain brand name instruments.

Flutes: Armstrong, Emerson, Gemeinhardt, Selmer, Yamaha, Jupiter

Clarinets: Buffet/Evette, Leblanc/Vito, Selmer/Bundy, Yamaha, Jupiter

Trumpets: Blessing, Getzen, Selmer/Bach, Yamaha, Eastman, Jupiter

Trombone: Conn, Holton, Selmer/Bach, Yamaha, Eastman, Jupiter

Alto Sax: Selmer, Yamaha, Conn, Jupiter

If you rent or purchase an instrument from one of the local music stores listed below and they recommend another brand, we trust their judgment.

5) **Class Schedule** Please mark the concert dates, times and locations on your calendar.

6) **Picking Up Your Child/Late Fees** S'cool Spirit teachers will wait with students until they are picked up. We ask that you pick them up directly after class. If, after 15 minutes, a child has not been picked up, S'cool Spirit reserves the right to charge parents \$1.00 per minute after this grace period.

7) **Practice** We suggest that each band student practices 20-30 minutes a day, three to four times a week in order to see ongoing improvement.

8) **Instrument Repairs** Your instrument needs to remain in playable condition. If your child's instrument starts to sound airy or does not produce all notes well, call the music store where you rented it. They can make necessary adjustments to the instrument.

9) **Dropping the Class** If you need to drop the class you must do it in writing (email is acceptable). Prorated refunds will be provided up until the third week of each semester.
